Integrated Subject Home Assignment

Topic: "Exploring Health and Well-being"

Objective:

Students will explore the different dimensions of health (physical, mental, and social), and reflect on how these factors contribute to overall well-being. They will present their findings in an engaging and creative way by incorporating insights from different subjects.

Science : Assignment Details:

- A) Take three small plants of same variety and same height and plant them in three pots A, B and C of same size and same material.
- B) Measure the height of each plant and count the number of leaves in each plant and write in the table in a chart paper. (The sample table is given below)
- C) Add little manure(vermicompost) in Pot A on day 1 and after every 10 days. Add little manure and fertilizers to Pot B on day1 and after every 10 days. Do add anything except soil in pot C. water the plants as and when necessary, so that they are not overwatered or get dried. Keep them in appropriate sunlight (neither less nor too much)
- D) Record your observations in the table made in chart paper after every 5 days. After every 5 days count the number of leaves, any new branches and height of the plant.
- E) Write your conclusion at the end of the chart by answering the following questions:
 - i) In which pot was the healthiest? Guess why?
 - ii) In which pot was the weakest?
 - iii) What is the difference between plants in pot A, B and C after 40 days?
 - Vi) What do you understand by doing this experiment?
- F) Take pictures with your plant and paste in the chart. Use any type of art, also use different colours to beautify your chart.
- G) Submit your chart when you come back after summer vacation.
